



Commonly Asked Questions- 2017

Race Bibs

- Please wear your race bib on your chest. Placing your bib on the back, leg or covering with a sweatshirt does not ensure accurate timing.
- Register by October 3rd to get your name on your bib

Finisher Medals

- Only participants wearing a visible race bib at the finish line will receive a finisher medal.

Shirts

- Each registration prior Nov. 10 is guaranteed a shirt of their size
- Registrations Nov. 10th and after are guaranteed a shirt BUT not of their preferred size.
- Adult shirts are Unisex Port & Company long sleeve performance blend. This is a soft cotton moisture wicking shirt. Adult: 4.5oz 65% polyester/35% cotton.
- Youth: 100% cotton.

Registration

- Accepting on-line registration only up until 11:59pm on Sunday 11/19/17.
- Walk-in registration will be accepted, ONLY IF THE EVENT IS NOT YET SOLD OUT, during packet pick-up hours on 11/21-11/22.
- Register by October 3rd to get your name on your bib
- Accepted forms of payment include Visa, Master card, Discover, AmEx., cash or check.

Can I register at packet pick up or race day?

No registration will be accepted on race day. Walk-in registration will be accepted, ONLY IF THE EVENT IS NOT YET SOLD OUT, during packet pick-up hours on 11/21-11/22.

We highly encourage you to register early. Registrations after the on-line deadline are not guaranteed a shirt or a shirt of your desired size.

Can I create a Team when registering?

Yes, you have the option to create a team or join an existing team when registering. Teams will be recognized at the event. There are no discounts for team registration.

Where can I pick up my packet

Do I need to bring my registration receipt to pick up my packet

Although not required we highly recommend you bring a receipt or proof on your mobile device in case there are any discrepancies. We will have a registration list of all participants on site.

Are there refunds?

Sorry, there will be no refunds.

Who does this race benefit?

The Roseville Turkey Trot benefits At Risk Youth Programs and other youth recreation programs in the city of Roseville. Where does the race start and finish?

The race starts and finishes at the Vernon Street Town Square in downtown Roseville, 311 Vernon Street. You can view the course map at www.roseville.ca.us/events

Race starts at 9am.

Is this event rain or shine?

Yes.

Can ride scooters/ bikes/ skates/ skateboards/ etc.?

For the safety off all participants, scooters, bikes, skates, skateboards, roller blades are not allowed. Strollers and jogging strollers will be allowed and will be asked to start at the back of the pack.

Are dogs allowed?

Dogs are allowed on the 5K course only. No dogs on the 10K course. Dogs must be on a short leash. NO retractable leashes. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their dog. Dogs will be required to line up at the back of the line.

How long to I have to complete the course?

Both the 5K and 10K courses will open up to traffic beginning at 11am. Runners/ walkers will be asked to move to the sidewalk to finish their run.

Average times for the course:

	<u>Run</u>	<u>Walk</u>
5K	20 - 30 min	50 - 75 min
10K	50 - 60 min	1.5 – 2.5 hrs.

Are there race awards?

Everyone's a winner! No top finisher awards will be presented. However everyone who registered will received a finisher medal at the finish line. The participant's race bib must be visible to receive a medal.

Chip Timing

The Turkey Trot uses the Jaguar Timing System, a state-of-the-art RFID chip timing system from innovative Timing Systems. Each participant's lightweight, disposable chip is embedded into the bib. The timing chip is read 100-150 times through a 75-foot approach to the antenna, with up to 1,000 reads a second. Multiple redundancies are in place to ensure accuracy and precision.

Yes you may pick up for family and friends. Be sure that those individuals are given the correct bib number. Names should be on the back on each bib.

Vendors will also be on-site.

Will there be food/ drink for the runners after the race?

Yes. Light refreshments will be provided to participants only after the race. (I.e. breakfast bars, water, fruit)
