SUMMARY PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The applicant requests the approval of a Design Review Permit, an Administrative Permit, and a Voluntary Merger to merge three parcels and allow the construction of a self-storage facility with a 258-square-foot office and a 1,253square-foot manager's apartment. The project will also include 614 square feet of garage and storage space and 494 square feet for a second-story patio area. The approval would allow the construction of approximately 43,680 square feet of portable self-storage units and allow one acre to be used for 28 RV spaces.
