

NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY (NOFA) FOR THE 2018 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG), HOMELESS PREVENTION AND RAPID REHOUSING (HPRR) FUNDS; AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING FOR THE CDBG AND HPRR APPLICANT WORKSHOP AND PREPARATION OF THE 2018 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Roseville is beginning its annual planning for the 2018 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program Year. The City is also using this application process to award its 2018 Homeless Prevention and Rapid Rehousing (HPRR) funding. Every year the City must submit an Annual Action Plan in order to receive CDBG program funding from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The primary objective of CDBG is the development of viable urban communities through the provision of decent housing, a suitable living environment, and expanded economic opportunities for low - and moderate - income individuals/families and communities. The Annual Action Plan describes the City's housing and community needs for the upcoming year and the planned actions to address those needs. The City is providing an opportunity to discuss local needs and proposals, and will solicit proposals for programs and projects to implement the Annual Action Plan. The HPRR funding is received from the former redevelopment funding and must be used to address homeless prevention and rapid rehousing.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Roseville Housing Division will hold a Community Needs and an Applicant Workshop on: Tuesday, January 16, 2018, at 10:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. respectively, in Civic Center Meeting Rooms 1 & 2, 311 Vernon Street, Roseville, CA. This community meeting will solicit public comments on local priority needs that will guide the preparation of the City of Roseville's 2018 Annual Action Plan. The meeting will also discuss the 2018-2019 application for CDBG and HPRR funding. The City anticipates receiving approximately \$585,000 in CDBG funding in 2018-2019, with an estimated amount of \$468,000 available for program and project awards, and a minimum of \$250,000 will be available in HPRR funding.
