



Johnson Pool Rehabilitation Project Moves Forward

Outreach and Grant Funding Application in Progress

The City of Roseville is planning for future repairs to the David R. Johnson Memorial Pool located at 100 D. Street. These repairs will refresh the community facility, bringing new life to this well-loved facility. The repairs will address accessibility, aging infrastructure, building and safety code updates, and functional improvements. This project aligns with the City Council's commitment to re-invest in older facilities and increase the community benefit of those facilities.

Grant Funding Opportunity

Proposition 68 is a statewide grant program approved by voters in 2018. There are many grant opportunities from this funding source. Pending Council approval, the City would like to pursue approximately \$3 million in funding from the Park Development and Community Revitalization Grant. Applications are due in

The grant is a competitive grant, so there is no guarantee of receiving an award; however, we feel this is a worthy project. The City plans additional public outreach over the next few months.

Priority Repairs

- Pool improvements to provide swimming options for all ages
- New shade for pool deck area
- Pool deck replacement for better accessibility
- Restroom upgrades for privacy, code updates, and accessibility
- Replacement of aging pool equipment
