

# Johnson Pool Virtual Public Workshop #1

## ❖ Meeting Notes:

-Conducting this meeting tonight is Heather Buck and Stacie Marchetti

-Johnson pool is located at 100 D Street

-This meeting is focused on the future repairs to the pool using Prop 68 grant funds. These repairs are required due to aging infrastructure, building and safety codes, updates, and functional improvements.

-City council is commitment to re-invest in older facilities and increase the communities benefit at those facilities.

### • Pro 68:

-Statewide program approved by voters in 2018. There are many grant opportunities under this funding source. The grant that is most appropriate for this project is the Park Development and Community revitalization grant. The grant process is competitive and the application is due in March 2021. We are looking to apply for 3 million dollars to complete these repairs planned.

### • Repairs and Priorities:

-Pool Improvements: Providing swimming options for all ages but a continued focus on learn to swim activities. We are exploring the idea of a beach entry on one end of the pool to provide better accessibility.

-Pool deck replacement to allow better accessibility for residents and to address any areas that are deteriorating.

-New shade for the Pool Deck area.

-Improvements to the pool mechanical building: replacing aging equipment to help support the pools improvements.

-Continue to maintain the mural that was painted on the Pool Mechanical Room. This was part of the downtown mural project. The city collaborated with blue line art to create murals in the downtown area.

-Pool House: Upgrade both restrooms for accessibility, code requirements, storage and privacy.

### • Next Steps:

-Additional Design considerations:

-We are taking the parking into consideration since it is limited at this facility

-We will be refining the improvement plans and obtaining cost estimates for those baseline improvements listed. We will begin with the things on the list that are required for code safety accessibility and/or to replace aging infrastructure.

-If budget allows, we may expand the scope of work to include more amenities.
