## **II-A MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 21, 2006**

# III-A PROPOSED DESIGN FEATURE ASSOCIATED WITH: DESIGN REVIEW PERMIT - 991 ROSEVILLE PARKWAY - NCRSP PARCEL 41 (RITE AID SHOPPING CENTER) - FILE # DRP 04-67.

The applicant requests direction from the Design Committee on the proposed design feature that will be incorporated into the Rite Aid Retail Center at the corner of Pleasant Grove Boulevard and Roseville Parkway. At their meeting of July 20, 2006 the Design Committee approved the DRP for the proposed shopping center with a condition of approval that required the applicant to develop alternative designs for an architectural feature on the corner. The proposed design features include blocked columns with associated artwork and water features. (Wiley)

Senior Planner, Mike Isom, presented the staff report and responded to questions.

Chair Clark opened the public hearing and invited comments from the applicant and/or audience.

#### DIRECTION

Chair Clark passed around photographs of fountains observed in Salt Lake City.

Mr. Petrovich brought in 3 additional photo exhibits (D, E & F) of different fountains from the Western States for the committee and staff to review.

The committee felt that the applicant had a great opportunity and location to do something other than the typical tiered water feature.

Per consensus of the Committee, the water feature shall incorporate, at a minimum, the following design components:

- 1. 360 degree design
- 2. Waterfall component
- 3. Natural form (e.g. free form, natural stone/boulders)
- 4. Integration into site design and landscaping
- 5. The water feature shall incorporate a bench/seating component

## **IV-NEW BUSINESS**

IV-A DESIGN REVIEW PERMIT – 10000 FOOTHILLS BOULEVARD – BLUE OAKS PLAZA – PROJECT # 2006 PL-034, FILE # DRP-000106. The applicant requests approval of a Design Review Permit for the construction of 17 office buildings and two retail buildings totaling 97,677 s.f., with associated parking, lighting and landscaping. (Cucchi)

Associate Planner, Joanna Cucchi, presented the staff report and responded to questions.

Chair Clark opened the public hearing and invited comments from the applicant and/or audience.
