

## PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

**Notice** is hereby given that on **November 13, 2014** at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, The **Planning Commission** of the City of Roseville will hold a Public Hearing at the **City Council Chambers located at 311 Vernon Street, Roseville, CA** for the purpose of considering an application for a **DESIGN REVIEW PERMIT MODIFICATION & CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT MODIFICATION – 1893 TAYLOR ROAD – GOLFLAND SUNSPASH TORNADO WAVE WATERSLIDE ADDITION – FILE #PL14-0488**.

**Request:** The applicant requests approval of Design Review Permit and Conditional Use Permit Modifications to construct a new water slide within the existing water park. The platform for the proposed slide will be ±65' which is similar in height to other slides and structures currently located at the water park.

All comments will be considered by the Approving Authority.

If you challenge the action of the **Planning Commission** on this matter in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the Public Hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Division at, or prior to the Public Hearing.
