

RESOLUTION NO. 03-546

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSEVILLE ESTABLISHING AN
IN-LIEU MITIGATION FEE FOR TREE REPLACEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Roseville's current in-lieu mitigation fee for the removal of protected trees is seventy-five dollars (\$75) per inch of the diameter at breast height of the tree; and

WHEREAS, the actual cost of tree replacement has increased since the current fee was established and the fee does not adequately reflect the cost of providing an inch of tree replacement credit; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission recommends that the in-lieu mitigation fee be raised from the current seventy-five dollars (\$75) per inch to one hundred eighteen dollars (\$118) per inch, which reflects the current actual cost to the City to purchase, plant, irrigate and maintain a one-inch replacement tree for a period of three years;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Roseville that the Council hereby establishes an In-Lieu Mitigation Fee for Tree Replacement in the amount of one hundred eighteen dollars (\$118) per inch of the diameter at breast height of the tree removed.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Council of the City of Roseville this 19th day of November, 2003, by the following vote on roll call:


