

General Information

- All fees or charges shall be calculated at a one (1) hour minimum unless otherwise specified.
- All fees for specified services shall be calculated by the Fire Department.
- Whenever a requester fails to cancel a requested inspection prior to the scheduled time of inspection, the standard inspection fee shall be charged, based on a one (1) hour minimum rate.

When required, no permit or approval shall be issued until facility or process is brought into compliance with applicable codes and the required service fee is paid in full.

CUPA/Hazardous Materials Compliance Incentive Program

To qualify for a 25% discount on annual CUPA permit fees, a business cannot have within the last three years, any Class 1 violations of CCR Title 22, Title 23, or Title 24.

A business also cannot have any repeat violations noted during the previous year's inspection. All other violations or deficiencies must have been corrected within 30 days of the last inspection. Annual permit fees must have been paid by the date indicated on the annual permit invoice. A business may qualify for this discount annually if the above listed criteria is met.

(Time motion study) x (Top step salary for current year) + (Indirect Costs) + (Direct Costs) = Fee

Fees will be updated each year and increases will be implemented on July 1st annually
