A plot plan shall be submitted and approved. Information to be included on the plot plan (to approximate scale):

- 1) Structures, combustible materials, streets and means for Fire Department access.
- 2) Clearance from audience, structures and combustibles listed.
- 3) Water source location.

PROCEDURES & CONDITIONS:

A bonfire shall be no more than 8 feet (2438.4 mm) in diameter and 6 feet (1828.8 mm) or less in height and shall burn not longer than three (3) hours. The size and duration of a bonfire shall only be increased by the code official when it is determined that the safety requirements of the situation and the desirable duration of the burn warrants the increase.

This permit can be revoked at any time when safety is in question!

1. Kindle and maintain fire at the approved location only. This permit is not transferable to another location.
2. Bonfires shall not be conducted within 50 feet (15240 mm) of a structure or combustible materials. Conditions that could cause a fire to spread to within 50 feet (15240 mm) of a structure shall be eliminated prior to ignition.
3. A minimum distance of 75 feet (22860 mm) shall be maintained between spectators and the bonfire. Adequate barricades shall be provided and shall surround the bonfire to protect the spectators from injury by flying brands or direct contact with the fire.
4. The bonfire shall consist of clean dry wood and a small amount of starter materials such as hay or small kindling. Flammable liquids shall not be used.
5. Applicant shall provide a garden hose attached to an adequate water supply. The stream of the hose shall extend 25' beyond the burn area.
6. Applicant shall stay in constant attendance. When finished, the fire must be completely out.
7. **Keep this permit at the site of the fire, readily available for viewing.** This permit shall be available on site to fire department personnel when requested.
8. Any person who allows a fire kindled or attended by him/her to spread to the property of another may be liable for damages caused by such fires (damages may include the cost of firefighting). Failure of the applicant to observe the above procedures and conditions may result in a citation and permission for the bonfire shall be immediately revoked.
9. **Discontinuance:** *The Chief is authorized to require that recreational fires be immediately discontinued if such fires are determined by the Chief to constitute a hazardous condition.*
10. *A fire engine may be required to provide standby service upon the discretion of the fire department.*

I accept this permit under the conditions stated and declare that I am the owner or legal occupant of the property upon which the burn is to be conducted or that I have the permission of the property owner. I understand that this permit is valid only for the date and time specified.
