

**Roseville Housing Authority**  
**Housing Choice Voucher Waiting List Opening**  
**Monday, October 15, 2012 at 9:00 am through**  
**Friday, October 19, 2012 at noon.**

The Housing Choice Voucher Program, funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, provides monthly rental subsidy to qualified, very low-income households to help reduce their rent payments.

This is not an emergency housing assistance program.

There is limited assistance available and there is a waiting list.

To apply, the family must not exceed the following income limits:

Assistance is based on income verification, eligibility requirements, Roseville Housing Authority preference factors and selection in the lottery. Pre-applicants who live or work in Roseville or Rocklin, are disabled, a veteran, a family with minor children, involuntarily displaced (at time of application only) or are Home Start graduates will receive preference when determining waiting list order. A computer generated lottery will be run and only 500 pre-applications will be placed on the waiting list. The date or time of an application, if submitted within the open period, will not affect an applicant's position on the waiting list. Roseville Housing Authority's on-line application forms are available in English and Spanish.

After you have successfully applied, you may print a receipt with a confirmation number and instructions for checking your status online. Status information will be available online only after November 1, 2012 at <https://www.waitlistcheck.com>. You will not be able to receive information regarding your application status by calling or coming into the Roseville Housing Authority Office.

If a person with disabilities is unable to access a computer to apply for the HCV Waiting List due to the nature of their disability (and is unable to have someone apply online on their behalf) they may request a reasonable accommodation for assistance with the application process. The written request must be received by Roseville Housing Authority no later than 12 pm (noon) on October 19, 2012.

The Housing Choice Voucher Program is a program of the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) designed to assist very low income families, the elderly and the disabled and help them afford decent, safe and sanitary housing in the privately-owned rental market. Income qualifications must be met in order to be considered for the Housing Choice Voucher program, in which one's income may be no greater than 50% of the Area Median Income. Those who qualify for the program will pay approximately 30% of their adjusted monthly income for their share of a monthly rent and Roseville Housing Authority, which administers the federal program, provides funds for the remainder.

Long recognized as one of the leading housing authorities in California, the Roseville Housing Authority continues to be an innovator in the field of affordable housing. Currently, Roseville Housing Authority provides housing assistance to over 600 elderly, disabled and low income Roseville and Rocklin households through its various programs.
