## **Future Meetings for Public Input on the Proposed Project**

After the end of the public scoping period, the consultants and City staff will consider the input about potential environmental issues and prepare the Draft EIR. The Draft EIR will be released for public review for 45 days. Members of the public and affected agencies will have the opportunity to provide written comments on the EIR analysis, environmental conclusions, and mitigation measures during the Draft EIR comment period. As required by CEQA, when the Final EIR is prepared, it will include written responses to important environmental issues raised in comments on the Draft EIR. When the Final EIR is complete, the City Council will hold a public hearing to consider certification of the EIR and to consider the merits of, and take action on, the project.

Due to the time limits mandated by state law, your response to the NOP must be sent to the City at the earliest possible date, but not later than 30 calendar days after November 18, 2013 (the date the notice was first posted). Please submit comments to the City of Roseville no later than 5 p.m. on December 19, 2013. Please provide written comments to:
