Findings

- **Dramatic growth is coming!**
 - We can shape growth, but not stop it
- **Demographics will change**
 - Older, smaller households
- **Land planning will shape transportation choices**
 - And transportation choices will shape land planning
- **Traffic from outside Roseville is a major issue**
 - But we only have partial control





Findings

- **Economic vitality is good for Roseville**
 - Supports services and quality of life
- **Housing availability affects community character**
 - Provides homes for the next generation
- **Environmental resources constrains growth**
 - E.g., surface water is required for new development
- **Local & regional actions are mutually dependent**
 - What happens in the region has an effect on Roseville
