



# Construction & Demolition Waste Management Plan Resource Guide

California AB 939 mandates cities and counties recycle at least 65% of their municipal solid waste, including construction and demolition debris.

The City of Roseville's (City) Construction & Demolition (C & D) Recycling Ordinance, Chapter 9.17.000, in conjunction with the adoption of CALGreen, ensures the City meets the State's regulatory requirements.

**Permit applications for projects listed below require the submission of a project Waste Management Plan (WMP).**

- All new building construction
- TI's, as part of the initial shell/structure only
- All demolition projects
- Any addition or alteration of 1000 sq. ft. or more
- Any non-residential project with a permit valuation or estimated construction cost of over \$200,000
- Any residential project increasing the building's area, volume, or size

**When submitting a WMP, applicants must select Option A, Option B, or Option C for waste hauling.**

- City staff may enter the job site to inspect waste collection areas.
- Per CALGreen, the California Green Building Code, 65% of all C & D debris generated must be recycled.
- All mixed Construction and Demolition material generated in the City of Roseville must be delivered to the Materials Recovery Facility at 3033 Fiddymment Rd. Roseville, CA.
- Only approved Non-Exclusive Franchise Haulers may be hired to collect and transport trash or mixed C & D material off of the job site.
- Construction and Demolition Debris may not be burned or dumped illegally.
- Part Three, The Waste Generation and Disposal Report, must be completed and submitted before your final inspection.
- You must keep all receipts or weight tickets from your project or a period of one year from the submittal of your Waste Generation and Disposal Report.

I have read, understand, and take responsibility for this project’s compliance with CALGreen and Chapter 9.17.010 of the City of Roseville’s Municipal Code.
