I am writing in response to your letter regarding the Silverado Oaks Urban Reserve Preserve Parcel 72, which is proposed to be included in the Woodcreek High School Nature Center.

As proposed in your letter, dated March 25, 2003, student field trips, clean up activities, a mowed trail, post and cable fencing, interpretive signage, native plantings, irrigation during the planting's establishment period (drip), and benches, within the staging areas depicted on the drawing, will be allowed in the Preserve as described in your letter and the accompanying drawing of the same date. Prior to the installation of the native plantings, a qualified biologist will review the planting locations to ensure that they are habitat appropriate. In addition, a qualified biologist will oversee the placement of the remaining structures/improvements so that the minimum disturbance to the preserve occurs.
