

Residential Weather-Based Irrigation Controller Rebate Program Terms and Conditions

1. Eligible irrigation controller must be purchased and installed between July 1, 2019 and June 30, 2020.
2. Participants must be a City of Roseville water utility account holder. Utility account must be in good standing to qualify.
3. New construction does not qualify.
4. The maximum rebate amount is up to \$150. Rebate amount shall not exceed the purchase price of the controller. Rebate shall be given for water efficient product material only. Items such as labor, wiring, electrical tape, covers etc. are excluded from rebate funding.
5. Application and itemized, paid receipt must be submitted within 90 days of purchase.
6. Paid, itemized receipts and/or itemized contractor paid invoices are required. Labor is not included.
7. Applicant must complete installation of new controller and schedule post inspection within 60 days of application submission.
8. Customer must have an existing automated irrigation system with an operable non weather-based irrigation controller that has, at minimum 4 active stations that irrigate 4 separate zones.
9. Old controller must be a non-weather-based model to qualify for replacement.
10. Participants agree to install, maintain, and manage the use of the weather-based irrigation controller for a minimum of 5 years. Participant agrees to give the City of Roseville permission (with a scheduled appointment) to enter the property for the purpose of conducting the mandatory installation verification.
11. Participants agree to relinquish the old irrigation controller to City staff at the time of post-conversion inspection. If the timer is discarded prior to a post-inspection, you will not be eligible for rebate.
12. Make/model number of current/old controller provided on application must match the device relinquished to the technician at post inspection.
13. The applicant is solely responsible for complying with any and all laws, regulations, policies, conditions, covenants and restrictions that may apply and for any and all liabilities arising out of a conversion project. Applicants are encouraged to consult any applicable covenants, conditions and restrictions ("CC&Rs") or neighborhood Homeowner's Association ("HOA") regulations that may apply to an anticipated conversion project prior to submitting an application with the City.
14. If the weather-based irrigation controller purchased requires a subscription service to operate effectively, participant agrees to purchase the signaling fees for a minimum of 5 years prior to receiving the rebate.
15. Participants are eligible for one rebate per meter.
16. Only EPA WaterSense approved weather-based irrigation controllers qualify for the Rebate. Qualified timers can be found at <https://www3.epa.gov/watersense/products/controltech.html>
17. Participation in this program does not exempt applicant from any water use ordinances that may become or are already in effect, including imposing landscape watering restrictions during periods of drought.
18. Rebate program is subject to available funding. Rebates will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis until funding is depleted. Submission of an application does not guarantee a rebate.
19. City reserves the right to modify or cancel the program at any time.
20. The program is designed to rebate a portion of the costs of controller upgrades and to encourage good water management.
21. Cost per unit must not exceed manufacturer's suggested retail price (MSRP).
22. **Disclaimer:** The applicant expressly agrees that City of Roseville (COR) may inspect all properties participating in the Residential Cash for Grass Rebate Program; that COR does not guarantee the performance of any piece of equipment; and that COR does not warrant any equipment or installation to be free of defects; the quality of workmanship, or the suitability of the premises or the equipment for the installation. The undersigned further agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless COR, its directors, officers, agents, and employees, from and against any and all loss, damage, expense claims suits and liability, including attorney's fees arising out of or in any way connected with the equipment(s) and its (their) installation. Applicant has read, understands and agrees to the terms and conditions listed on the Residential Cash for Grass Rebate Program. Applicant understands that installation of qualifying water efficient equipment may not result in lower water bills. COR reserves the right to add or remove eligible water efficient equipment from the list or change the terms of the incentive.
