


Bike & Pedestrian Improvements for Downtown Roseville

Refurbishment and rotation of the Rube Nelson "Ice House" Bridge, connecting the trail across Dry Creek



Taylor Street pedestrian bridge, connecting Royer Park to the Downtown Library

It replaces the previous bridge that was removed following storm damage a few

years ago



New downtown pedestrian bridge, connecting Royer Park and the Vernon Street Town Square
The bridge will have enough space for vendors and activities during special events
